Your student's language proficiency will be evaluated in the four language skills: Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening. *The grade will reflect what students are able to <u>do</u> with the Spanish language.* 

Spanish I and II proficiency grading will is aligned with the North Carolina Essential Standards proficiency expectations for each level, and their grade will reflect their progress in relation to the proficiency expectation:

## Level 1(Novice-Mid) and Level II (Novice-High):

**70% Summative/Major grades**: reading, writing, listening and speaking assessments, projects that require target language input or output. Late major assignments will be 10 points deducted per day late.

**30% Formative/Minor grades:** quizzes, homework, classwork. **Late Work** is <u>not</u> accepted on minor assignments (homework, classwork). Late work includes homework not turned in on time, class work not turned in but student was present in class, and any other minor assignment not turned in by the due date.
